CFCA 2020 Wearable Arts Show Information

DATES

-The Wearable Arts Show will take place on Saturday, September 26, 2020 at the Centre for Creative Arts in the Dance Studio.

-There will be a rehearsal at 3pm, with shows at 5pm and 7pm.

-There will be 1 or 2 other rehearsal dates, one being a dress rehearsal on Thursday, September 24 in the evening.

-Artists and their models **NEED** to be able to commit to at least the dress rehearsal and all day on Saturday, September 26.

WEARABLE ART

-All wearable art pieces must be created by the artist(s) using any materials you can think of. The more outlandish, the better.

-Wearable art is not clothing, it is art using the body as a canvas. Please do not submit regular clothing, your pieces must be out of the ordinary.

-All pieces **MUST** be complete by September 11.

-You can submit any number of pieces, but each artist is limited to two performances maximum. Example: If you have three pieces, you can have all of them in one performance interacting on stage or split them up and have two in one and one on it's own.

-Think about the piece as a character. What is the mood of the piece? Are they happy and bubbly, creepy, mysterious?

-Consider hair, make-up and props to complete your piece.

MODELS

-Artist may model their own pieces or find their own models.

-Children may model, but the artist is responsible for them while they are at the Centre.



-Models will need to sign a release form; children will need a parent to sign for them.

PERFORMANCE

-Think about a piece of music to go with your performance. You will need to provide a copy of your music later. Links to iTunes or YouTube do not work; we need the actual song file.

-Each performance will be between 30 seconds to 2 minutes long.

-The stage will be set up as it was last year.

It is 4' x 32' with a 4' x 8' piece sticking out the middle, with a  curtain behind it. 

-Think about what kind of performance or dance will go with your piece.

RULES

-This is a family friendly show, so no gratuitous nudity or violence.

-No guns or knives, unless they are obviously fake.

-No inappropriate music.

-No throwing things into the audience

-Nothing that poses any safety hazards.

-Dressed models **MUST** be able to walk up a set of stairs and walk the runway without assistance.
