Sewing kit

If never attended a class at the centre, tote bag first then one of the following projects.

Bag (not required if already have attended any sewing classes at the centre)

¼ meter of outer fabric and ¼ meter of lining fabric and one small spool of matching thread for this project

Suggested Projects

McCall's 8250 a hooded sweatshirt and pants,

Materials as per pattern and one spool of thread **FABRICS:** 35% Moderate Stretch Knits: Sweatshirt Fleece, French Terry, Milky Fleece, Fleece. **Pocket Lining C:** Tricot.

Note: Fabric requirement allows for nap, one-way design or shading. Extra fabric may be needed to match design or for shrinkage. **NOTIONS: C:** ¾ yd. (0.7 m) of 1" (2.5 cm) Elastic.

McCall's M8489 Girls overalls and pinafore for summer

Butterick B6937 Dress, romper and hat

McCall's M7942 shorts, pants and top

McCall's M7678 PJs

McCall's 7379 Top, cargo pants

These patterns again are only suggestions, they will complete an difficult project or several simple pieces during our time.

But they need to have a pattern in the appropriate size range, fabric and notions as indicated on the back of the pattern envelope, and thread to match the fabric for the project if unable to match go darker in all cases.

A difficult project would be lined jacket, or a garment with lots of detail, and more than 7 pattern pieces
